Requirements and Qualifications

- » Part-time or full-time enrollment at the University of Minnesota, Duluth for the current semester.
- » Ability to show professionalism in a newsroom environment.
- » Familiarity with journalistic ethics as well as copyright laws and guidelines.
- » Must be confident taking your own images and able to meet with and photograph a variety of people.
- » Must have solid knowledge of DSLR camera operation, intermediate understanding of photography principles, and a professional portfolio of work to show as samples. (You do not need to own your own camera. You may use cameras and equipment from the Media Hub.)

Responsibilities

- » Directly reports to the Visual Director and works closely with Graphic Designers and other Photographers/Videographers as a member of the Art Team. Works closely with Reporters and Editors.
- » Captures a variety of photography including: portraits, sporting events, special events, and other story-specific photography on a weekly basis. Photography may be paired with articles, (in print or on the website,) used in stand alone photo essays, or be used for social media and marketing of The Bark.
- » May have up to three or four photo assignments per week. If no assignments are needed in a given week, the photographer is expected to capture file photos for The Bark of campus and surrounding areas for future use.
- » Actively participates in weekly budget meetings.
- » Makes time to Table for The Bark for a minimum of one hour per month.
- » Expected to respond to other team members in a timely manner.
